3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom of Heaven
4. The Transfiguration
5. The Institution of the Holy Eucharist

The Sorrowful Mysteries (Tuesdays & Fridays)

1. The Agony in the Garden
2. The Scourging at the Pillar
3. The Crowning with Thorns
4. The Carrying of the Cross
5. The Crucifixion

The Glorious Mysteries (Sunday & Wednesdays)

1. The Resurrection
2. The Ascension
3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit
4. The Assumption
5. The Crowning of the Blessed Virgin

How to Pray the Rosary

1. Begin the Rosary with the Sign of the Cross and the Apostles' Creed.
2. Continue with the Our Father, 3 Hail Marys for an increase of faith, hope, and charity, and Glory Be.
3. State the first mystery; pray the Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer while meditating upon this mystery.
4. Repeat this for each subsequent mystery.
5. At the end of each day's rosary, say the Hail, Holy Queen and concluding prayers.

Rosary Prayers

The Sign of the Cross

With your right hand, trace a cross by touching your forehead, then chest, left shoulder and right shoulder while saying: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into Heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our

trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the Fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Fatima Prayer

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, and save us from the fire of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.

Hail, Holy Queen and concluding prayers
